


About the Gesa Power House Theatre

The historic Gesa Power House Theatre is a state-of-the-art performing arts theater located in downtown Walla Walla, Washington. The 120-year-old building was once the Walla Walla Gas Plant, originally built to produce coal gas and pipe it underground to light the streets, businesses and homes of Walla Walla. The building was converted to generate electricity around 1905 by installing steam-driven dynamos and transformers.

In 2011, the interior of the building was transformed into the performing arts theater you see today. The interior design, featuring a thrust stage and balcony seating, was inspired by the intimate Blackfriars Theatre in London, which William Shakespeare and his acting company began using in 1608. Formerly a decommissioned monastery, the Blackfriars Theatre's interior was converted to the winter indoor performance space of the King's Men, and Shakespeare's plays were produced there regularly for more than 30 years.

The Gesa Power House Theatre has been named to the list of state historic buildings by the Washington State Building Preservation Commission, and in January 2012, the theater was officially named to the National Register of Historic Places. The theater hosts a variety of programs from live theater and dance to music concerts and comedy acts.
