Steve Fossen and Michael Derosier, bassist and drummer for the band Heart during the 1970s and early 1980s, are now touring as Heart By Heart. The band also features vocalist Somar Macek, guitarist/ keyboardist/vocalist Lizzy Daymont and guitarist Chad Quist.

Heart By Heart presents a dynamic show that includes all the favorite Heart hits as well as deep album cuts that fans will love.

Fossen and Derosier are the powerful driving engine behind Heart's classic hits like "Barracuda," "Straight On," "Crazy On You," "Magic Man," "Even It Up," "Dog & Butterfly," "Heartless," "Kick It Out," and more. Formed by Steve Fossen in 1969, Heart went on to release six top-10 albums and landed 20 hit singles on the Billboard Top 40 chart.

In recognition of their contributions to these iconic recordings, and to Heart's first seven years of national and international touring, Fossen and Derosier were inducted into The Rock & Roll Hall of Fame with the rest of the original Heart lineup in 2013.



Paula's guest appearances include The Late Show with Stephen Colbert, Star Talk with Neil deGrasse Tyson, and Late Night with Carson Daly. She was a clue in a New York Times crossword puzzle and voiced the character "Forgetter Paula" in Disney/Pixar's Inside Out. Paula cohosts a new weekly podcast for Maximum Fun, Nobody Listens to Paula Poundstone, with Adam Felber, a friend and fellow Wait Wait panelist.


GEORGE WINSTON



Celebrated pianist George Winston is undeniably a household name. He's inspired fans and musicians alike with his singular solo acoustic piano songs for more than 40 years while selling 15 million albums. A tireless road warrior playing nearly 100 concerts annually, live performance for Winston is akin to breathing. Winston's music is evocative, offering us all a chance to take a step back from our perpetually busy lives and let our minds adventurously wonder.

George Winston's classic albums, *Autumn* and *December*, are perennial favorites, along with *Winter into Spring*, *Summer*, 2017's *Spring Carousel – A Cancer Research Benefit*, as well as two volumes of the compositions of Vince Guaraldi, two volumes of benefit albums for the Gulf Coast disasters, and six other solo piano albums.

George Winston released his 15th solo piano album, *Restless Wind*, via Dancing Cat Records/RCA Records on May 3, 2019 and is currently on tour in the United States. *Restless Wind* is a portrayal of Winston's place in a chaotic world – his compositions extend solace with an idiosyncratic grace.

CHE APALACHE



Che Apalache is a four-man string band based in Buenos Aires with members from Argentina, Mexico and the United States. The group's founder is Joe Troop (fiddle), a North Carolinian multi-instrumentalist, singer-songwriter and composer who moved to Argentina in 2010. While patiently carving out a niche in the local music scene, Joe taught bluegrass and old-time music for a living. That's how he met Pau Barjau (banjo), Franco Martino (guitar) and Martin Bobrik (mandolin), his most dedicated students. They quickly became picking buddies and in 2013 decided to hit the stage.

Che Apalache began as a bluegrass band, but eventually incorporated Latin American styles into their repertoire. Combining instrumental prowess with tight vocal harmonies, they have created an authentic blend of genres to reflect the nature of their lives. Evoking images from Appalachia to the Andes, their debut album, "Latingrass," is a testament to a powerful cultural and musical exchange.

At the prestigious Appalachian String Band Music Festival in Clifftop, WV they were awarded first place in the Neo-Traditional band competition.







Our History

The historic Gesa Power House Theatre is a 300-seat performing arts venue located in downtown Walla Walla, Washington. The 130-year-old building was once the Walla Walla Gas Plant, originally built to produce coal gas to light the streets, homes, and businesses of Walla Walla.

Around 1905, steam-driven dynamos and transformers were installed and the building was converted to generate electricity.

In 2011, the building was purchased and the inside was transformed into a performing arts theater. The interior design, featuring a thrust stage and balcony seating, was inspired by the intimate Blackfriars Theatre in London, England, that William Shakespeare and his acting company began using in 1608. Formerly a decommissioned monastery, the Blackfriars Theatre's interior was transformed into the winter indoor performance space of the King's Men, where Shakespeare's plays were produced regularly for over thirty years.

The Gesa Power House Theatre was named by the Washington State Building Preservation Commission to the list of the State historic buildings, and in January 2012 the theater was officially accepted to the National Register of Historic Places.

Today, Gesa Power House Theatre stages a variety of professional productions featuring comedy, music, family programs, films, theater, and more. In addition, businesses, nonprofits, and private groups rent the theater for functions and events.

In 2018, at the 20th anniversary of their estate vineyard, Foundry began the transition to become USDA Certified Organic which will be completed in 2020.

Foundry Vineyards invites you to visit their tasting room just west of downtown which features a contemporary art gallery, sculpture garden (perfect for picnicking), and a curated design store. This family owned and operated winery not only creates extraordinary wines but also seeks to promote the arts by offering a host of gallery openings and intellectually stimulating events throughout the year. One thing is certain, when you visit Foundry Vineyards you will have a truly unique wine tasting experience.
